The Company

Independently owned and operated, the Wainwright operation offers full service gas, oil, diesel and windshield washer fluid. The operation also has convenience food, soft drinks, snacks, tobacco products and a lottery terminal and a restaurant offering a full range of meals.



The Work

The operation has approximately ten full time employees, including cashiers, servers, cooks and secretary. Shift work, including weekends and evenings is required.

The Ideal Candidate

The ideal candidate to work at Husky Travel Centre & Restaurant should have the following attributes and qualifications:

- Food handling experience and Food Safe certification
- Excellent customer service skills
- Willing to learn

Cook

- Responsible for short orders, food preparation, breakfast, and full menu meals
- Must have Grade 12 diploma
- Have at least two or three years of experience
- Be proficient in the use of all kitchen equipment, including fryers, ovens
- Food Safe Certificate a must
- Must be safety conscious
- Must be reliable and conscientious
- Must be fluent in English

Servers

- Must be friendly, outgoing
- Must have excellent communication skills
- Responsible for taking food orders
- Must take pride in giving excellent customer service
- Occasionally responsible for taking payment for food and other items
- Knowledge of food items, and Food Safe certification

Cashier

- Must have excellent customer service skills
- Good communication skills
- Ability to run lottery terminal
- Responsible for taking payment by debit, credit or cash
- Must be computer literate
- Must be 18 years of age
- Capable of selling cigarettes, groceries and snack foods
- Grade 12 Diploma

Secretary

- Responsible for invoicing and payouts
- Must be computer literate
- Must have basic bookkeeping skills
- Responsible for general administrative duties
- Grade 12 diploma

Training

In house training is provided to all employees. Food Safety training is arranged after probationary period has been completed.

Hours of Work, Pay and Benefits

The store is open from 6:00 a.m. until 10:30 p.m. daily.
The restaurant is open from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m.
Staff are required to work shifts within these hours, including weekends and evenings.

Salary is based on experience and performance. Staff share tips. Employees receive a food discount. Health and dental benefits are available on a 50/50 shared basis.
