### The Company

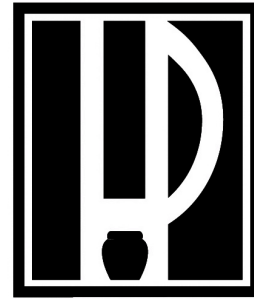

The ideal candidate will have the following skills and personal attributes:

The Honeypot employees work in the following positions: Chefs, Cooks, Prep Cooks, Customer Service and Dishwashers.

Formal education is not a requirement, as employees will be trained to do things “the Honeypot way”.

**Training**

Employees are provided with a six-day training period. The company supports the Alberta Friendship program and currently has three apprentices on staff.

*Servers*

- Greet patrons, present menus, make recommendations and answer questions regarding food and beverages
- Take orders and relay to kitchen and bar staff
- Recommend wines that complement patrons' meals
- Serve food and beverages
- Prepare and serve specialty foods at patrons' tables
- Present bill to patrons and accept payment
- Must be well groomed
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Positive attitude is absolutely key
- Must have the ability to be trained
- Must complete ProServe on line



*Cooks*

- Prepare and cook complete meals or individual dishes and foods
- Clean kitchen and work area
- May plan menus, determine size of food portions, estimate food requirements and costs, and monitor and order supplies.
- May specialize in preparing and cooking ethnic cuisine or special dishes.

**Hours of Work**

The Honeypot is open Monday to Saturday with the Restaurant open from 11:00 am to 9:30 pm and the Pub open from 11:00 am to 11:00 pm. Employees work shifts within the hours of operation.

Wages are competitive and commensurate with position and experience, plus gratuities as appropriate. Vacations are in accordance with the provision in the *Labour Standards Act*.
